

LAKE WOOD COLO RADO

Lakewood, CO has become one of the most attractive cities in the United States for residents of all ages. With close proximity to both Denver and the Rocky Mountains, there's something new to explore indoors and outdoors every day. With nearly 75,000 jobs across all industry sectors, including government, education, and health care, Lakewood has a healthy economy and plenty of job opportunities for new residents.

Using the Light Rail, Lakewood residents can commute to Downtown Denver in about 15 minutes. The system connects Denver, Lakewood, Littleton, Highlands Ranch, Parker, Centennial, Aurora, and other areas within the Denver metro including a line to and from Denver International Airport.

Belmar, a bustling 22-block center built around a central plaza, has more than 80 retailers and restaurants, as well as art galleries, a movie theater, and contemporary apartments. This urban district attracts thousands of Lakewood residents and tourists with its excellent shopping, dining, and entertainment which includes winter ice skating in the plaza and live music on summer weekends!

With 99 parks in the city, there are more than 7,000 acres of green space and trails, making up nearly 35% of Lakewood's total area. William F. Hayden Park and Bear Creek Lake Park are the two largest parks in Lakewood at 2,400 and 2,600 acres respectively!

Red Rocks Amphitheatre is a renowned live music venue in Morrison just 15 minutes from Lakewood. A Colorado hot spot for music lovers, this outdoor venue is 6,450 feet above sea level, making the views literally breathtaking. With two 300 ft. amplifiers (Creation Rock and Ship Rock) and beautiful scenery, there's no other music venue like it in the world!

Finally, with a population of just over 150,000, the best thing about Lakewood is its residents. They work hard and play hard. With an average age of 38.5 and more than 300 days of sunshine, Lakewood residents enjoy healthy, active lifestyles. Lakewood is a great place to raise a family with top-rated schools and a high percentage of homeownership.
