
Over the past several years, First Presbyterian Church has seen an increase in young families, which has brought a newfound energy into our congregation and has positioned us for growth.

OUR CHURCH

Sunday School Classes

We have a strong Sunday School program for all ages, with many active and vital adult classes.
Additionally, we have a Men's Ministry and a Women's Ministry, and small groups for men, women, youth and children which meet regularly.

Fellowship

We, as a community of family, seek to embody Christian love as we gather with and partner with our covenant community. This manifests itself as we care for one another, pray for one another, and seek genuine Christian fellowship with one another.

Missions

We pride ourselves in having a heart for missions. We sponsor individual missionaries locally, nationally, and internationally, and have multiple annual mission trips both nationally and abroad. We have regular programs featuring our mission causes, and our members participate monthly in serving at the local homeless shelters and weekly at local elementary schools. From the county jail to mission efforts in Romania, Belize, and North Korea, we are always eager to embrace worthy causes and see this as one of the vital outreaches of our church.

The Learning Center (TLC)

The Learning Center was founded in the early 1980's. Today, TLC serves 170 students. Fully realizing that the early years of life are the most important for laying the foundation of faith, social, emotional, and cognitive development, the school provides each child with acceptance, respect, and love in a Christian environment. TLC is a cherished ministry of FPC, and a wonderful outreach opportunity within our church.



Wichita Falls Community

Wichita Falls is a welcoming community. Although it is the largest city in the area, with over one hundred thousand residents, it maintains a small town feel, supporting a multitude of family-owned businesses dating back to the early 1900's. The city offers a thriving downtown with shopping, theaters, and restaurants. There are numerous popular special events including concerts, festivals, rodeos, and the nation's largest bike race, the Hotter'N Hell Hundred.

Midwestern State University, located across the street from First Presbyterian Church, is a public liberal arts college with over 6,000 students. It is the state's only public liberal arts college. Sheppard Air Force Base is located just five miles north of downtown Wichita Falls and is the largest and most diversified Air Education and Training Command training base. The University and the Air Force Base help maintain a flow of diverse cultures, ideas, and life throughout the city.

Wichita Falls is a great place to raise a family and put down roots. The average living expenses fall nearly 15 percent below the national average. Housing costs are 14 percent less than the average American city, with the median home price in the region listed at about \$119,000. The city boasts highly affordable living, a low unemployment rate, 37 beautiful parks, and a 20 mile concrete trail system that rivals that of much larger metropolitan areas. Only two hours away from major metropolitan cities like Dallas and Oklahoma City, Wichita Falls represents the best Texas has to offer.
