THE POSITION

The Director of Local Outreach & More Life Community Center is a part of and provides oversight to our Community Involvement Zone. This person oversees our zone's efforts to lead people to serve the needs of our community and serves as the Director of our More Life Community Center. This position reports to the Executive Pastor. This is a full-time, salaried, zone-director level position with benefits.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Zone Leadership – Provide leadership to the Community Involvement Zone positions, Pastor of Recovery Ministries and Pastor of OutServing Ministries.

Department Leadership – Develop an annual department strategic plan and budget to accomplish the departments overall vision and ministry objectives.

More Life Community Center

- Develop and oversee this venue to help CCC extend its worship by identifying and meeting the practical needs of our Congregation and Local Community.
- Involve the congregation's skills and vision in the development of the services offered.
- Ensure the More Life Community Center upholds the dignity of each individual and family it seeks to serve through appropriate staff training and operating practices.
- Develop strategic partnerships with local authorities, businesses, and public services in meeting community needs.
- Work closely with Community Involvement events and programs to most effectively mobilize our congregation in service to our local community.

Shepherding – Share the pastoral shepherding of the congregation by participation in the Pastor of the Day and Emergency Pastor on Call rotations as well as performing weddings and funerals, administering the Compassion Fund, and making hospital visits.

The Need Before Us

The suburbanization of poverty and our poor economy have created more poor among us. No longer is the day where the poor live primarily in a centralized portion of our city. We have pockets of poverty all around – even in our own congregation.



Our Guiding Philosophy

We are called by God to bring our city the Good News and the Good Deeds of Christ – that our community would experience God's love and come into a personal relationship with Him. It is often the case that churches tend to emphasize one of these aspects over the other. A church focuses on our spiritual poverty yet neglects meeting the physical poverty before them or vice-versa. At Colorado Community Church we desire to offer a balance, non-lopsided approach to how we live. We want to give people bread for their bodies and the "bread of life" for their soul so as to respond to all the needs (spiritual, physical, emotional) of those in our community. As many resource organizations are "needs" driven, we at the MORE Life Center are relationship driven, and, thus, we strive to meet individual and household needs at the "speed of relationship."

Our Founding Convictions

Dignity

we will treat every person with dignity as a bearer of God's image with inestimable value and worth. We never put ourselves in a position of power over the individual's we serve. We do not make people feel indebted to us.

Exchange

we believe each person has something of value to give in exchange for any assistance they may receive. This might be through volunteering time in a variety of ways or participating financially each according to their ability, and thus serving others as they themselves have been served.

Relationship

we move "at the speed of relationship." Relationship with those we serve is the cornerstone to our approach of helping to bring More Help, Hope and Life to each and every person that walks through our door. We believe transformation happens best in relationship.

Divine Provision

we believe it is ultimately the Heavenly Father who will meet every need – at times using us and at times through others – but we always point people to Him as the ultimate provider in their life.

Jesus came to bring life abundant and through walking in partnership with a Life Champion every person will receive the assistance, dignity and relationship necessary to appropriately aid in their whole life development.

COMMUNITY


